Wick suggestions are for fragrance oils. Customers who use 100% essential oils will have to perform your own wick testing.

Below you will find the various types of wicks Natures Garden offers. Use this guide when determining which wick to use for your projects. This guide should not be considered a substitute for testing.

Zinc-core wicking	Most popular wicking, Used in all applications
CD flat braided coreless wicking	Almost self-trimming, Very popular in soy/veggie waxes
HTP all cotton braided	Very popular wicking in soy/veggie waxes.
Hemp core wicking	All natural, Hot burn, Very popular in soy/veggie waxes
